DAX Full Service

DAX Copilot

DAX Copilot is integrated directly into PowerMic Mobile and Dragon® Medical One, and the clinical summary is available immediately after you complete the recording. Using your voice, you can tap into a full suite of customizations, templates, and shortcuts that allow you to personalize your notes using Dragon Medical One's advanced speech capabilities and time-saving EHR workflows.

When to use DAX Full Service

- You want the clinical summary placed into the note in the EHR
- You want information copied and pasted from the EHR into the note
- You want to use your templates
- You want your note customized to your preferences

When to use DAX Copilot

- You want the note immediately after the recording is finished
- You want to use Dragon Medical One to add your auto texts
- You want to edit the clinical summary on your phone or desktop
- You are seeing patients that are not on your schedule
